



## Alfred Eddy Harth

August 1, 1923 - October 2, 2007

Alfred Eddy, son of Fern Alice (Morland) and Hubert William Harth was born August 1, 1923 Northwest of Alva. He passed away on the 2nd of October at the age of 84 years 2 months and 1 day.

He attended the Farry School system, where he graduated from Farry high school on May 15, 1942.

Mr. Harth served in the Army during WWII; serving in the European Theater with Company D, 782D tank battalion as a Sherman tank driver. After serving our country he came back to Alva and worked for Gilbert Fisher as a house painter.

On May 5, 1956 he was married to Ina Darlene Wilks in Derby, Ks. To their marriage one son, Lannie Dean, was born.

Following their marriage they made their home in Wichita, Ks and he worked as a house painter. In 1971 the family moved to Tucson, Arizona where he raised and raced greyhounds at Tucson Greyhound Park, moving back to Alva in 1978 working as a self employed painter until he retired in 1989.

He was preceded in death by his parents, a sister, Iva Lou McDonald, three brothers, Ollie, Leonard, and Harold Dean.

Mr. Harth is survived by his wife, Darlene and a son Lannie both of Alva; three sisters Hazel Wagoner of Wellington, Kansas, Fayette Acord and Anne Wendling both of Alva; a brother and his wife, Ben and Nancy of Winfield, Kansas; a number of nieces, nephews other relatives and friends.
