Ann Lee Egenuia, daughter of Maggie (McBride) and John Garrett was born on March 20, 1925 in Moon, Oklahoma. She passed away at the Alva Share Medical Center on the 27th of November at the age of 84 years, 8 months and 7 days.

She attended grade school in Zafra, Oklahoma and graduated from Smithville High School with the class of 1944. She then attended the Wilburton College. Miss Garrett was married to William Herman Crawford on November 23, 1944 in Hatfield, Arkansas. To their marriage three children; Johnny Lee, Shirley Ann and Danny Duane were born. Following their marriage they came to Alva where Herman was stationed at the prisoner of war camp. After his discharge they continued living in Alva. Ann worked for several Cafés and cooked for the Moose Lodge. She then was a Stanley Home Product Dealer.

She was a member of the Reorganized Church of Latter Day Saints and the Ladies Auxiliary of the V.F.W.

Mrs. Crawford was preceded in death by her husband, Herman on May 14, 1986, a daughter, Shirley Ann on December 31, 1961, a son, Johnny Lee on June 16, 1966, and her parents.

Ann is survived by her son and his wife, Dan and Susan of Alva, four grandchildren; Christina Black, Corey, Carey and Chad Crawford.
