Betty Jewel, daughter of Wilma Fern (Baxter) and Lester LeRoy Barnes was born in Alva on April 9, 1941. She passed away at the Oklahoma Heart Hospital in Oklahoma City on the 23rd day of September at the age of 72 years, 5 months and 14 days.

She attended the Alva school system where she graduated with the class of 1959.

Miss Barnes was married to Stanley E. Stoner on June 2, 1959 at the Alva 1st United Methodist Church. To their marriage two daughters, Brenda Kaye and Vicki Dawn, were born.

Following their marriage they made their home in Alva where she worked for Anthony's. Then they purchased the Singer Sewing Store and renamed it Alva Sewing center.
