May 2, 1929 - June 26, 2014

Donald Dee, son of Eva (Snyder) and Deyoe Rogers, was born May 2, 1929 in Hardtner, Kansas. He passed away at the Kiowa Manor on the 26th day of June, 2014 at the age of 85 years, 1 month and 24 days.

He attended the Hardtner school system. In 1951 he joined the United States Army and was honorably discharged in 1952.

After returning from Germany he courted Elfreda Fae Corr and they were married in Medicine Lodge, Kansas on May 5, 1956.

To their marriage four children, Lucretia, LaDonna, LaVonne and Lindsey were born.

Following their marriage they made their first home in the old hardware store in Hardtner, and then they moved one mile south and two east on the George Winn Farm.

Donald was a member of the Hardtner United Methodist Church, the Stateline American Legion Post, and past commander of American Legion Post 175.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Elfreda, a daughter Lucretia; his parents; six brothers; a sister, and a son-in-law Bill Rose.
