Edgar Allen, was born on a farm northeast of Alva, Oklahoma on March 17, 1929, the youngest son of Otto and Millie Schwerdtfeger and passed from this life on February 27th at Beadles Nursing Home, Alva Oklahoma at the age of 89 years, 11 months and 10 days.

He lived his entire life on County Road 460 within a half mile of where he was born.

Edgar attended Capron High School graduating in 1947.
