



## Floyd Dean Witchey

February 20, 1934 - March 24, 2017

Floyd Dean was born February 20, 1934 to Blanche (Crabb) and Floyd Elmer Witchey. He passed away March 24, 2017 at the age of 83 years, 1 month and 4 days at Grace Living Center in Woodward, OK.

He lived near Whitehorse and attended school at Farry. From an early age he had the ability to diagnose and repair anything imaginable. He worked as a mechanic until he was drafted into the US Army in 1957.

Dean served until 1959, attending Air Defense Artillery School at Ft. Bliss and was stationed near the Panama Canal. Upon returning to the United States, he put his natural talent to use working on cars and motorcycles, then began working for Amoco Oil Company in 1966. Over twenty seven years later he retired from Amoco with a perfect safety record.

Retirement didn't slow Dean down at all. He rode his Harley Davidson, tinkered on engines and traveled to visit friends and family often. He dedicated much of his time to running the Farry School Reunion, where he loved gathering with old classmates, teachers and friends.

Dean had four boys; Kelly, Gene, Larry and Ryan. His greatest joy came from his five grandchildren; Hayden (1987-2006), Tori (18), Ryan II (7), Eva (5) and Destiny (3).

Dean believed in God and is reunited with his family now.

Dean is survived by his four sons, grandchildren, brothers Earl and his wife Mavis of SD; Dale of AZ and sister Gail Wilks of Alva.

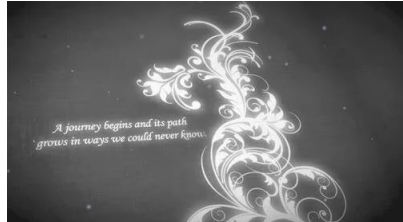

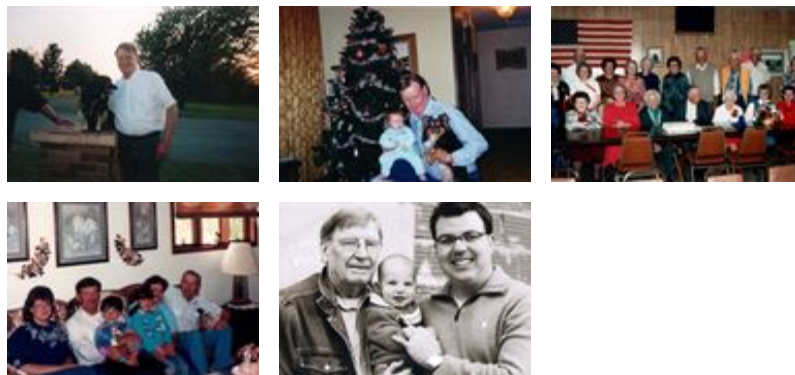
