Frieda Wilhelmine, daughter of Lena (Detmer) and Benjamin Meier was born near Lincoln, Kansas on October 29, 1902. She passed away at the Alva Share Medical Center on the 9th of May at the age of 105 years, 6 months and 11 days.

She attended the Elkhorn Township School and the Lutheran School near Lincoln, Kansas where she learned German. In 1920 the family moved to Broken Arrow, Oklahoma.

Miss Meier was married to G.H. Wiersig at the Lutheran Church in Broken Arrow on August 21, 1927. To their marriage three children, Hubert, Arlene and Virgil were born. G.H. passed away on November 25, 1975.

Following their marriage they lived on a farm two miles South of Alva where they made their home for 74 years where she helped in farming. She was a wonderful homemaker and loved the outdoors including gardening looking after cattle and helping with the harvest. She will be greatly missed by her family and friends. In 2002 she came to the Homestead to make her home and later at Share Convalescent Home.

Frieda was baptized as a child

and confirmed on April 1, 1917 at the Lutheran Church at Lincoln, Kansas. Her faith in God was her constant guide.

Mrs. Wiersig was preceded in death by her son, Hubert on November 27, 2006, her parents, a sister, Anita Rauh three brothers, Walter, Fred and Alfred.

Frieda is survived by her son and his wife, Virgil and Lavon of Alva, a daughter, Arlene Thies and a daughter-in-law, Loris Wiersig both of Oklahoma City. Nine grandchildren and their spouses, Patti Lambert, David and Phyllis Wiersig, Peggy and Jeff Robbin, Doug and Leigh Wiersig, Steve Thies, Lynette Thies, Monte and Kathleen Thies, LeAnn and Shane Storck and Kurtis and DesiRae Wiersig.
