Gary Kent, son of Anna Louise (Harrington) and James George Ewing was born March 8, 1943 in Hardtner, Kansas. He passed away at Share Convalescent Home in Alva, Oklahoma on the 12th of May, 2013 at the age of 70 years, 2 months and 4 days.

He attended school in Capron and Hardtner graduating with the Class of 1961.
