February 16, 1932 - September 13, 2006

Harold Dean, son of Fern Alice (Morland) and Hubert William Harth was born on February 16, 1932 near Farry, Oklahoma. He passed away at the Alva Share Medical Center on the 13th of September at the age of 74 years, 6 months and 27 days.

He attended the Farry School System and Graduated with the class 1951. He farmed for the Maxwell brothers until he joined the United States Army on November 5, 1956 serving in the Tank Corp in Germany and was discharged as corporal on November 27, 1960.

On October 5, 1956 he was married to Ella Banks at Pawhuska, Oklahoma. To their marriage a daughter, Kim was born.

Following their marriage they lived in Arkansas City, Kansas and he worked Kent Well Service, later Skyline Mobile Homes.

Mr. Harth was preceded in death by his parents, a sister Iva Lou McDonald, two brothers, Ollie and Leonard.
