



## Harold Add Johnson

May 7, 1920 - September 27, 2009

Harold Add son of Nettie Ethel (Broomhall) and James (Jack) Perry Johnson was born May 7, 1920, Northwest of Alva in the Flagg Community. He passed away at the Beadles Nursing home in Alva on the 27th of September at the age of 89 years, 4 months and 20 days.

He attended the Flagg Rural Grade School and Farry High School.

On September 17, 1942, he joined the United States Army where he was assigned to the 9th Air Force Supply Division serving in France, Germany and England. He was Honorably Discharged as Corporal on February 14, 1946.

After returning home he worked for several farmers in the Alva area.

Harold was an avid Goldbug and Ranger Fan. Even though he was blind he listened to every game on the radio.

Mr. Johnson was preceded in death by his mother on December 10, 1980; his father on February 8, 1961; two sisters, Helen Bailey on March 11, 1938 and Yvonne Morgan on September 9, 2009; two brothers, Wilbert on April 19, 1990 and Junior on November 6, 2005.

Harold is survived by a sister, Donna Faye Dunning of Wichita, Kansas; a brother and his wife, Don and Darla Johnson of Memphis, Tennessee; two sister-in-laws, Lucille Johnson of Alva, Oklahoma and Wilma Jean Johnson of Liberal, Kansas; a number of nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.
