



## Harry Davis Fisher

March 1, 1950 - October 16, 2018

Harry Davis Fisher was born March 1, 1950, in Alva, Okla., to Gilbert and Dorothy (Hageman) Fisher. He passed away on October 16, 2018 at the age of 68 years 7 months and 15 days.

He attended school at Alva, graduating with the class of 1968, and attending Northwest State College for one year before joining his father with Fisher Paint Company full time.

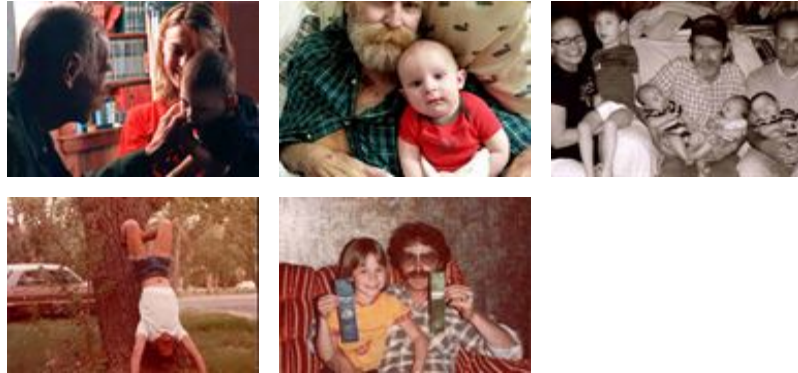
