



## Hazel L. Case

January 24, 1923 - June 26, 2016

Hazel Laverne was the firstborn child of seven to Cleeta Mae (Yates) and Harry William Myers. She was raised on a farm near Hardtner Kansas, where she attended school. She passed peacefully from this life on June 26, 2016 at the age of 93 years, 5 months and 2days.

Her mother died when Hazel was 12 years old, leaving her to help provide care for her younger siblings.

Miss. Myers was married to Lotus Aldon (Red) Case on August 7, 1940 and spent most of her married life in Alva. After raising their two children, she joined her husband in opening and operating the Daylight Donut Shop in 1968, continuing until his death in 1977. She subsequently worked for several Alva retailers including Magnuson Grocery and Holder Drugs, and later provided assistance to elderly in the community.

She was active in the First Baptist Church until her health and vision loss prevented her attendance there. In addition to time with her family, she spent many hours attending to her yard, flowers and home, taking great pride in her efforts. She also loved to travel, taking trips with her children and their families.

Hazel was preceded in death by husband "Red", her grandson Jason Daniel Case, and siblings Virgil, Forest, Bethel, Donald and John.

She is survived by her son Jim Case (Barbara) of Alva, and daughter Georgia Beltz (Fred) of Clinton Township Michigan in addition to grandchildren Brandon Case, Sara Tandoc and Kristyn Ross. In addition to three great

grandchildren, Aurora, Matthew and Lucas, she is also survived by her sister Virginia living in Dallas Texas and other nieces, nephews and other relatives and friends.

She is remembered with great love by those who mourn her loss and celebrate her life.
