June 20, 1926 - April 24, 2021

Hazel Pauline was born on June 20th 1926 to Edwin and Mabel (Branch) James. She was born near the Farry Community in rural Woods Co. Oklahoma. Hazel passed away on April 24th, 2021 at the Kiowa District Manor at the age of 94 years 10 months and 4 days.

Early on Hazel attended Farry Rural School and after she graduated from there she enrolled in the Nurses Corp. at St. Francis Hospital in Wichita, Ks to become and RN. She then began her career as a nurse at the hospital in Alva, Oklahoma.

Hazel Married Alvin Herren on January 1st, 1948 in Buffalo, Oklahoma. To their union two sons were born, Randall Fienz and RexAlan.

Following their marriage Hazel and Alvin moved to Buffalo in August of 1948 where they farmed. In January of 1950 they moved to Okmulgee so that Alvin could attend Okmulgee A&M.

In 1951 Hazel moved to Oklahoma City where she worked under a doctor and Alvin worked for OG&E electric company. After spending some time in the city Hazel and Alvin moved to Kiowa, Ks in 1958 where hazel worked at Kiowa Hospital and Alvin started with J&R electric.

In 1975 Hazel returned to school to further her education and become a Physicians Assistant. She was known by everyone as "Nurse Hazel".

Hazel retired in 1985 and joined Alvin on the farm they had purchased.

After Alvin's Passing, she stayed in the Kiowa-Alva area residing at Homestead and lastly at the Kiowa Manor.

Hazel was preceded in death by her husband, Alvin, her parents, and two brothers, Stanley and Edwin.

Hazel is survived by her two sons, Randall of Apache Junction, AZ and Rex of Sidney, MT. Four grandchildren Jeff, Brian, Christopher and Miranda and 6 Great Grandchildren

One sister, Norma Jacobs of Kiowa and numerous nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.

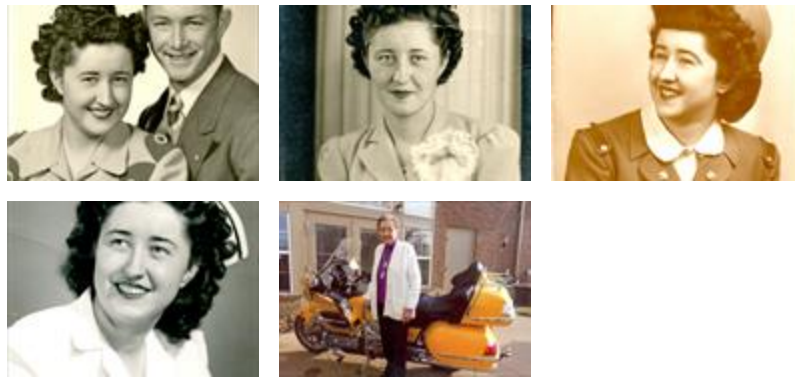
