



Hubert Crawley Karns

January 8, 1922 - July 25, 2008

Hubert Crawley, son of Johnnie Crawley (Fowlkes) and John Thomas Karns was born on January 8, 1922 in Marshall, Arkansas. He passed away at his son's home in Roundup, Montana on the 25th day of July at the age of 86 years, 6 months and 17 days.

He attended the Marshall Arkansas school system where he graduated from high school with the class of 1940 and attended Central Arkansas University. In 1942 he enlisted in the Army Air Corp and served in England with the 8th Air Force.

On October 8, 1957 he was married to Mary Ellen Stewart at Marshall, Arkansas. She passed away July 18, 2001.

Following their marriage they made their home in Wichita, Kansas working for Boeing Aircraft Company. In 1969 they were transferred to Lynnwood, Washington. In 1987 he retired from Boeing. In 2005 he went to Roundup, Montana to live with son.

Mr. Karns was a Member of the Lynnwood Baptist Church and a member of the Masonic Lodge of Marshall, Arkansas receiving his fifty year pin.

He was preceded in death by his parents, three sisters, Louise, Elizabeth and Vina Mae and two brothers, John Arthur and Luther.

Hubert is survived by a daughter, LaKatia Martin of Aurora, Colorado and a son and his wife John and Krista of Roundup, Montana. Three grandchildren and their spouses, Lacynda and David Devora, Michael and Janie Emery and Jonathan Karns. Three great grandchildren, Drake Devora, Ellena and Gabriel
