Ida attended the Freedom School System and graduated high school with the class of 1947.

Miss Sample was married to Leon Howland on August 11, 1946 in Freedom. To their marriage three children, Gwendolyn Faye, Rosalie Ann and Brian Leon were born.

Following their marriage they have made their home in Freedom. In 1951 they purchased the Freedom Motor Company and retired in 2005.
