



Idelle Ophelia McDaniel

August 10, 1913 - January 27, 2013

Former Alva resident Idelle Ophelia Taylor McDaniel, 99, died January 27 at Trevecca Health Care Center in Nashville, Tenn.

Born August 10, 1913, in Carbon, Texas, to John Henry and Zettie Wilson Taylor, she was preceded in death by her husband, the Rev. Marion F. McDaniel, and brothers J.D. and Henry L. Taylor.

She is survived by three daughters – Charlotte (Tom) McAnally of Nashville, Tenn. ; Carolyn (John) Westcote of Colchester, Conn.; and Cathy (Wesley) Johnson of Cimarron, Kans., five grandchildren, and 11 great-grandchildren.

Mrs. McDaniel resided most of her adult life in Oklahoma where her husband was a United Methodist minister and farmer. Together they served United Methodist churches in Freedom, West Union, Lookout, Mutual, Kenton, Martha, Thomas, Yewed and Prairie Valley near Cherokee, Fairview and Catesby near Laverne, and Wapanucka. She had special interest in music and evangelism.

Following her husband's death in 1982, Mrs. McDaniel continued to reside for seven years in Alva. In 1989 she moved to Nashville to be near her daughter and family. She was a member of Calvary United Methodist Church in Nashville.
