John David was born August 12, 1942 in Wichita Ks to Edith Allison (Blunk) and James B. Hendrix. He passed away February 23, 2015 in Alva at the age of 72 year, 6 mo., and 11 days.

He attended Hardtner, Ks school and graduated with the class of 1960. From there John joined the Air Force until 1964. He attended Wichita State University in 1964. In 1976 he graduated from Hutchinson Community College with an AA degree- Fire Science.
