



Johnette Frances Beagley

October 23, 1948 - November 25, 2013

Johnette Frances was born to Lila Iona (Lyon) and John Scribner in Alva, Oklahoma on October 23, 1948 and passed away on November 25, 2013 at the age of 65 years, 1 month and 2 days at Mercy Hospital in Oklahoma City. Johnette was raised in Alva and graduated from Alva High School with the class of 1966.

Miss Scribner married Rex Beagley on February 19, 1966 and resided in Alva with their son Scott. She graduated from Northwestern Oklahoma State University in 1970 and attended medical technology school at Mercy Hospital in Oklahoma City where she and Rex moved following graduation.

She worked as a registered Medical Technologist in Oklahoma City and in 1985 she and her husband opened Mustang Parts of Oklahoma. They retired in 2008 and returned to Alva to farm and ranch.

Johnette was a faithful member of the First United Methodist Church and served on the UMW of the church. She was president of Household Executives, Secretary of the Tulip Garden Club, member of the 20th Century Club, member of Women of the Moose organization, and member of the Democratic Party of Woods County. In addition, she served on a committee for the Oklahoma Cooperative Extension Service. Johnette coordinated many blood drives for the Methodist Church.

Johnette was preceded in death by her parents and brother, Harold.

She is survived by her husband Rex, son Scott, two brothers, Edward Scribner and his wife Claudia of Oklahoma City and James Scribner of Alva;

brother-in-law Steve Beagley and wife Carolyn; granddaughters Brandy and Allyson, and many other relatives and friends.
