July 18, 1921 - May 28, 2009

Herbert Milton, son of Ruth Jane (Martin) and Herbert Roscoe Quinn was born on July 18, 1921 near Hopeton, Oklahoma. He passed away at the Alva Share Center Nursing Home on the 28th of May at the age of 87 years, 10 months and 10 days.

He attended the O.K. Rural Grade School District # 15 near Hopeton. He attended Horace Mann High School with the class of 1940. He had enlisted in the 45th Signal Corp on October 2, 1939 and entered active service on September 16, 1940. They invaded Africa, Sicily, Naples-Foggia, Rome-Arno, Southern France, Central Europe and the Rhineland. He was honorably discharged at Camp Chaffee, Arkansas on July 27, 1945.

On August 9, 1945 he was married to Genevee Haltom at the Hopeton Church by her grandmother, Rev. Grace Nelson. To their marriage a son, Austin was born in 1946.

Following their marriage they made their home in Alva. Jr. was manager of several furniture stores for forty years retiring from C.E. Loomis furniture store in 1986.

He was a member of the Alva First Christian Church where he served on the board, was a deacon and elder emeritus. He was also a member of the Alva Masonic Lodge number 105 and a 32nd Degree Mason. He was also a Member of the American Legion, V.F.W. and a past member of the Kiwanis Club.

He was a Member of the Alva Golf and Country Club where he was an avid

golfer. Jr. also took great pride in maintaining his yard at home. He was preceded in death by his parents and his brother, Leon. Jr. is survived by his wife, Genevee of 64 years, his son and his wife, Dr. Austin and Peggy of Shawnee, a niece, Darlene Monroe of Purcell, a sister-in-law and her husband, Marcile and Art Lancaster of Alva, and several nieces and nephews and other relatives and friends.
