Kenneth (Ken) Laverne Yohn born on September 3, 1941 in Denver, Colo., and died on February 1, 2011, in Auburn, Calif.

Preceded in death by parents Floyd and Alice, of Tucumcari, N.M. Survived by his spouse, Betty, his sister, Karen Smith of Mt. Pleasant, Tex., and two sons, Steve Yohn of McKinney, Tex., and Ed Yohn of Amarillo, Tex.

Ken was a polio survivor, being diagnosed as a small boy with the disease.

Ken enjoyed a few passions, but none more than collecting old cars (Chevy's only), and Johnny Cash music. He was an avid motor racing fan for more than 50+years.

Interment will be in Alva, Oklahoma where the Yohn family farm was homesteaded more than 100 years ago.
