On April 5, 1945 he enlisted in the United States Army during WWII. Serving in Japan in the 82nd Airborne Division, he was Honorably discharged May 14, 1947.

Lawrence worked as a auto mechanic and drove race cars. In 1954 he came to Alva and started working at the Alva Post Office in 1976 he helped his brother build grain elevators.

L.D. attended the Baptist Church in California. He was a former member of the Alva Elks Lodge and The V.F.W.

Mr. Steffen was preceded in death by his parents and a brother, Russell.
