Linwood Junior Paul died on August 7, 2017 in his home in Hot Springs Village, AR. Linwood, 97 years old was born to Emma Wiebener Paul and Linwood Boyer Paul on January 3, 1920. He was born in Alva, OK in the home of his paternal grandparents. He attended Short Springs School for one year.
