



Lloyd Raymond Brockus

July 3, 1945 - October 31, 2008

Lloyd Raymond, son of Delores Elaine (East) and Lloyd Raymond Brockus Jr. was born on July 3, 1945 in Nashville, Tennessee. He passed away following a lengthy illness at the Enid Integriss Bass Baptist Health Center on October 31, 2008 at the age of 63 years, 3 months and 28 days.

He attended the Alva School system and graduated from High School with the class of 1964. He attended Northwestern State College for five years majoring in music. He taught as a student teacher at the Freedom Public School for one semester.

On November 12, 1966 he was married to Sylvia Jeanne Daniel in Alva, Oklahoma by her father Reverend Loyd Daniel. To their marriage a daughter Charlotte was born.

Following their marriage they made their home in Alva. He was employed at the Alva Review-Courier for several years where he learned basic photography and taught himself advanced photography. Later he made his living writing outdoor hunting and fishing stories and selling wildlife and nature photography. He was published in several State and National magazines including: Outdoor Oklahoma, Oklahoma Today, Game and Fish, Southern Outdoors, Field and Stream, Fins and Feathers, Petersen Publications, and many others. He also displayed his photography at art shows and galleries.

Mr. Brockus was a member of the United Methodist Church.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his grandparents, Cordelia and Lloyd R. Brockus Sr. and Gladys and Ed East; and an uncle, Dale Burrill.

Lloyd is survived by his wife Sylvia of the home; his daughter and her husband, Charlotte and Rodney Rapp, of Wakita; a sister and her husband, Carlotta and Edward Perkins, of Alva; a niece and her husband, Seslie and Daniel Pugh and their family, all of Woodward; and an aunt Gladys Burrill, of Tyler, Texas.
