She graduated from Classen High School with the class of 1941 and attended Oklahoma A&M.

While attending High School she met Sherman Reece Scott and they were married on July 15, 1944 in Camp Lee, Virginia. To their marriage two sons, Bruce and Terry were born.

After Sherman returned from serving in WWII they made their home in Woodward. In 1950 they came to Alva where she worked as the Woods County Deputy Treasurer, Assistant to the County Superintendent of Schools and Assistant to the District Attorney. She was also a very dedicated wife and mother. Sherman Passed away May 4, 1975.

Marjorie was an excellent seamstress and quilter and won blue ribbons at the county fair with her quilting projects. She also enjoyed cooking and canning; and was known for her excellent sand plum jelly. She was a member of the Alva First Presbyterian Church.

On August 24, 1985 Marjorie married Floyd E. Hampsten in Norman, Oklahoma. They continued to make their home in Alva. Floyd passed away September 3, 2001. Marjorie has made her home in Oklahoma City for the last few years.

Marjorie was preceded in death by her both her husbands and her parents.
