Arthur L. Son of Jane (Meyer) and Loren Britcher – was born on March 7, 1923 in Clarence, Iowa. He passed away at Integris Bass Hospital in Enid OK on 4 March at the age of 98 years, lacking 3 days of his 99th birthday.

He attended schools in Muscatine, Iowa. He served in the Army Air Corp. from 1943 to 1946 during World War II he was a Staff Sergeant, a top turret gunner and engineer on a B-17.

Mr. Britcher was married to Charlene Kallenberger on May 4, 1946 at the first United Methodist Church in Muscatine, Iowa. To this union two children Eloise Kaye and Pamela Jo were born.

Following their marriage they lived in Muscatine, Iowa. In 1961, they moved to Littleton, Colorado where he worked as a custodian at the Plum Creek elementary school. He retired in 1991 and they came to Alva to live and he started working at Wharton funeral Chapel.

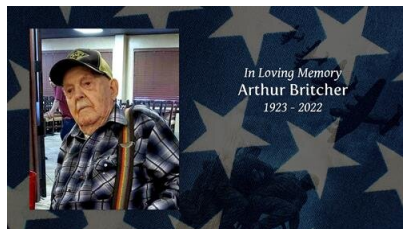
