Nadine Lois Keitel was born on September 18, 1930 and passed away on December 25, 2016 at the age of 86 yrs, 3 months, and 7 days. Nadine was born in Capron, Oklahoma to Walter Joseph and Hulda (Quast) Kunzman. She graduated from Capron High School in 1948. Obtaining her degree in Business, Nadine graduated from NWOSU, she worked for the Alva Farmer's Co-op in book-keeping.
