Orie Beryle, son of Nellie Mae (Storey) and Orie Morris Stauffer was born on February 9, 1923 in Ingersoll, Oklahoma. He passed away at the Alva Beadles Nursing Home on the 28th of February at the age of 84 years, and 19 days.

He attended the Lambert School System and graduated with the Class of 1943. After graduating he joined the U.S. Army. He was honorably discharged May 5, 1946, from the 39th Photo Reconnaissance Squadron in March Field, California.

On August 25, 1946 he was married to Maxine Ole at the Alva First Christian Church. To their marriage five children; Donnette, Jeannette, Craig, Kim and Kurt were born.

Following their marriage they made their home in Cherokee, then a mile west of Lambert and in 1950 east of Alva, where they farmed and raised cattle and sheep. He was a Custom Harvester for 50 years and also drove the school bus for the Alva School System.

He was a member of The Alva First Christian Church, 4-H, FFA Booster Club and T N T Square Dance Club.

Mr. Stauffer was preceded in death by his son, Orie Craig, a grandson, Dustin Graves, his parents, two sisters; Nellie Veryl Porter and Margaret Sennett.

Orie is survived by his wife, Maxine, two daughters; Jeannette and her husband Roger Graves and Donnette Stauffer all of Alva. Two sons and their wives; Kim and Arlene of Ponca City, and Kurt and Jan of Alva, a daughter in
