Patsy Ruth daughter of Susie Esther (Conway) and Harry E. Parker was born on the farm two miles east of Avard on August 30, 1926. She passed away on the 29th of December 2014, at the age of 88 years 3 months and 29 days. She graduated from Avard High School with the class of 1944. Patsy attended Enid General Hospital School of Nursing under a WWII G.I. Bill to obtain her Registered Nurse certificate and graduated in 1947. She came back to Alva and worked at the Alva General Hospital on 14th Street after graduation. She also worked at Share Medical Center.

Ms. Parker was married to Robert Samuel Wharton at her parent's farm on August 7, 1951. To their marriage three children were born, Patricia Ann, Robert Alan and Robyn Sue.

She was preceded in death by her parents, two sisters, Esther Reiman and Marvel Bixler, four brothers, John, Robert, Harold and Raymond.
