Peggy Jean, daughter of Juanita Maude (Guthrie) and Gerald Leon Hastings was born on November 21, 1934 in Anthony, Kansas. She passed away at the Enid St. Mary's Hospital on the 30th of June at the age of 74 years, 7 months and 9 days

She attended the Wakita School System where she graduated with the class of 1952. On May 11, 1982 she received her Bachelors Degree in Library Science.
