Robert Dean, son of Inez Lucille (Morrison) and Harold Edward Galbreath, was born on August 4, 1941 near Aline, Oklahoma. He passed away at the Meridian Nursing and Rehab Center in Wichita, Kansas on the 8th day of August at the age of 70 years and 4 days.

He attended the Dacoma School System and graduated with the class of 1959. He was active in the FFA showing sheep and hogs.
