



Robert Dale Murrow

March 20, 1936 - September 28, 2021

Robert Dale, son of Dorothy Freda (Miller) and Cecil Wayne Murrow was born on March 20, 1936 in Alva, Oklahoma. He passed away at his son and daughter-in-law's home on a farm near Cherokee, Oklahoma on September 28, 2021 at the age of 85 years 6 months and 8 days.

Dale attended and graduated from the Farry School System with the Class of 1956.

Dale was united in marriage to Nell Jean Coltrane on July 14, 1956 at the Cora Church. To their union 4 children were born Cecilia, Steve, Robert and John.

Following their marriage, they moved to Alva where Dale worked for Loomis's Furniture and Carpet as a carpet layer and installer. He later went to work for the Oklahoma State Highway Department. He retired with over 30 years of service in 1996. In 2011 he moved to the farm outside of Cherokee, Oklahoma to live with his son and daughter-in-law.

He was preceded in death by his parents Cecil and Dorothy, the love of his life Nell Jean, a daughter Cecilia and son-in-law Randy, two brothers, infant Johnny and Phillip, a sister Loretta, and two great grandchildren Makinzie and Quintin.

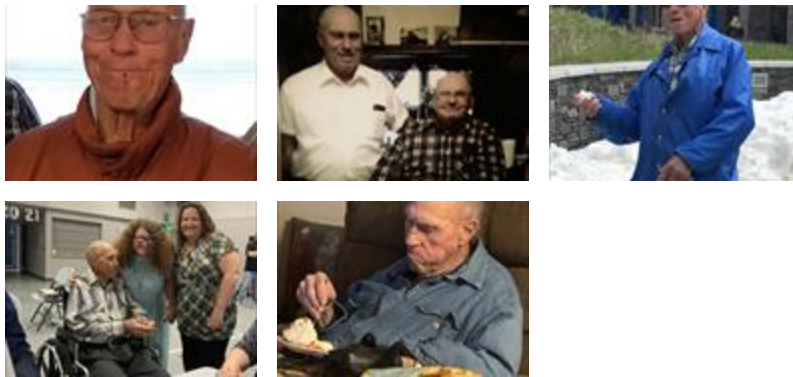
