



Russell Dale Murrow

August 3, 1926 - January 24, 2009

Russell Dale son of Ada (Graham) and Frank Murrow was born on August 3, 1926 on a farm south of Alva. He passed away suddenly at his home on the 24th of January at the age of 82 years, 5 months and 21 days.

He attended the Cracker Box rural Grade school and graduated from the Lambert High School with the class 1944. He joined the United States Army during World War II and then was recalled during the Korean Conflict.

On May 26, 1951 he married Merle Jean Klick at Phoenix City, Alabama. To their marriage two sons, Franklin and Kevin were born.

Following their marriage they farmed and ranched south of Ashley and he sold cars for Holderby Ford. In 1970 they came to Alva to make their home.

He was a member of the Odd Fellows, Elks and the Moose Lodges.

Mr. Murrow was preceded in death by his parents and a brother, Paul.

Russell is survived by his two sons, Kevin and Franklin and his Wife Cheryl; and his companion Donnetta Joachims and all of Alva. Four grandchildren Chenaë, Ross and Rozlynn Murrow. Cherie and her husband Jim Hurst and a step-grandson Nolan Hurst.
