April 25, 1940 - January 16, 2015

Seva Lou Bullard, born April 25, 1940 in Fairview, OK to Charles Ambrose Bullard and Sarah Olive (Bays) Bullard. When Seva Lou was six years old the family moved to Two Buttes, CO to be near her father's brother & family. After two years they moved to Dacoma, OK to be near her mother's brother & family. Her parents bought a small restaurant and she worked with the family taking care of the business as a young child.

She was a student in the Dacoma School System from third grade thru her sophomore year. She was active in the Pep Club, Glee Club and other school and Church activities. Her family moved back to Colorado, this time to Lamar. There she participated in various activities in school; summers were spent fishing (one of her favorite hobbies). She also was an avid reader, knitter & crocheter. She made many beautiful things for her nieces and nephews. She graduated from Lamar High School in 1958 and went to work right away as an office manager, bookkeeper/secretary for several different businesses. After several years of being out of public school she enrolled in the Lamar Community College.

Seva Lou was baptized in Canton Lake, OK during the Bays Family Reunion by her pastor cousin, Archie Taylor, what a wonderful event. In 1996 Seva Lou moved to Alva, OK and there she opened a loan business. In 1998 she sold her business to a company in Lawton, OK. They hired her to work for them, so off to Lawton she went. She lived in Lawton, OK until May of 2014 when she lost her health & her nieces insisted on moving her to Alva, OK so she would

be closer to her sister Jewel and her nieces Deana, Julie, & Shelley. One month later in June Seva Lou became very ill and chose to go to live at Beadles Rest Home where she died on January 16, 2015 at age of 74 years, 8 months and 22 days with her family by her side. Family was very important to her.

Seva Lou is preceded in death by her parents, two brothers, Charles King Bullard of Wyoming, Jerry Keith Bullard of Colorado, two sisters Lois Lee Emick and Alberta Joy Scobee, both of Colorado, two nephews Roger Dean Scobee, of Colorado; Terry Kim Bullard, of Colorado; one niece Jeanne Kay Bullard, of Wyoming, a great nephew Elliot Cole Burton, of Oklahoma.
