Sherrill Preston, daughter of Alfred and Frances Edwards, was born August 30, 1936 in Odessa, Texas. She passed away December 25, 2019 at St. Mary's Hospital in Enid, Oklahoma at the age of 83.

She was the oldest of two children. Sherry attended Wink High School and graduated in 1953 and then attended North Texas College, majoring in Education in 1957.

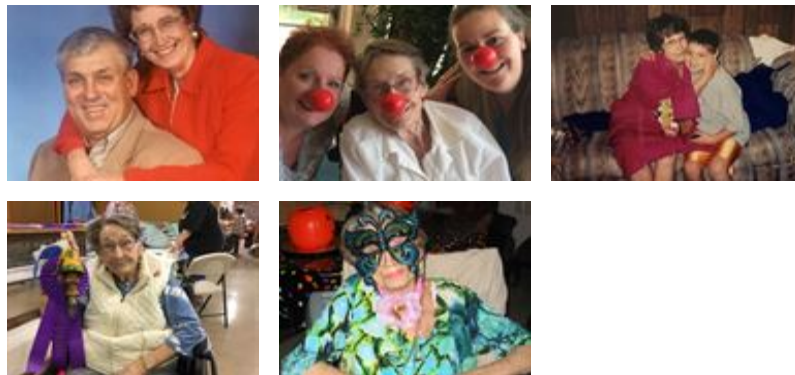
