Shirley Ann, daughter of Genevieve (Toelle) and Edward Barrett was born December 4, 1943 in Fredrick, Oklahoma. She passed away at St. Francis Hospital in Wichita, Kansas on the 27th of May at the age of 68 years, 5 months and 23 days.

She attended the Alva School System and graduated with the class of 1961. She attended Northwestern Oklahoma State University where she received a Bachelors of Science Degree. In 1966 she graduated from St. Francis Hospital School of Medical Technology. Shirley went on to receive more training and became a Specialist in Hematology.

Margaret Province.
