Verna Lucille, daughter of Eva (Moore) and Joe Schiffner was born July 18, 1918 was born on the farm near Ingersoll, Oklahoma. She passed away at the Alva Beadles Nursing Home on the 4th day of May at the age of 92 years, 9 months and 16 days.

She attended the Elm Dale Rural grade school through the Eight Grade and then Horace Mann High school. She attended Northwestern State College and then received her nursing degree from the Enid General Hospital in 1942. Miss Schiffner was married to Ernest V. Svoboda on May 3, 1944 in Alva. To their marriage a daughter Eva Kay was born.

Following their marriage they lived in Ellsworth, Kansas and she worked at the Veterans Memorial Hospital.

In 1953 she and Eva Kay returned to Alva and she worked for the Alva General Hospital, Dr. Hinkel and Woods County Health Department where she retired.

She was married to Floyd Readnour on April 29, 1970 in Alva, where they made their home. Floyd passed away September 30, 1984.

She was a member of the Alva First Christian Church (Disciples of Christ). Mrs. Readnour was preceded in death by her parents, a grandson Tony Rodgers; two sisters, Hannah Schiffner and Sylvia Gannon and a brother Alfred Schiffner.

Verna is survived by three daughters and their husbands, Eva Kay and Robert Grauer of Wilson, Kansas, Linda Rodgers and Alfred Perks, of Alva and
