Vicki Ann daughter of Claude Adams and Katherine (Farrell) Adams was born November 7, 1937 in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. She departed this life to be with her Lord, Monday, May 20, 2019, at her home, at the age of 81 years. She was surrounded by her children and her beloved husband.
