Virgil L. son of Susie Esther Conway and Harry E. Parker was born on the farm two miles East of Avard on October 24, 1931. He passed away July 30, 2015 at the age of 83 years, 6 months and 6 days at Alva, Oklahoma.

He graduated from Avard High School with the Class of 1950. He attended Northwestern Oklahoma State University. Virgil then worked several jobs including Boeing at Wichita, Stiles-Wharton Funeral Chapel and the ASC Office. He also farmed on the Centennial Farm that his grandfather homesteaded in 1893.

Virgil and Lydia R. Chaloupek were united in marriage at Canton, OK on January 26, 1968. They made their home in Alva, Carmen and then later on the Parker Homestead where they farmed and raised cattle.

Mr. Parker also worked at the Helena Boys Home and later James Crabtree Correctional Center. After retiring from Crabtree, Virgil then went to work at Wal-Mart until 2005.

Virgil was a member of the Avard First Christian Church and the Alva Masonic Lodge #105.

He was preceded in death by his parents, four brothers and three sisters.

Virgil is survived by his wife, Lydia, numerous nieces and nephews and many friends.
