Waneva Arlene, daughter of Eldra Armenta (McConkey) and Samuel Loveless Butler was born on September 16, 1924 at Catoosa, Oklahoma. She passed away at the Enid St. Mary's Regional Hospital on the 30th of May at the age of 83 years, 8 months and 16 days.

She attended the Whitehorse Rural Grade School and graduated from the Farry High School with the class of 1942. She started working at Douglas Aircraft Plant in Tulsa, where she met Fred Parsons.

Miss Butler was married to Fred on August 6, 1947 at Claremore, Oklahoma. To their marriage six children, Carolyn, Carl, Earl, Rita, Gail and DeeAnn were born. Mr. Parsons passed away on September 22, 1976.

Following their marriage they lived at Hallowell, Kansas and then came to Alva to make their home. She worked as a cook at the Alva General Hospital, the Washington Grade School. In 1971 she started working at the Woods County Health Department as a home care nurse and in 1985 retired.

Mrs. Parsons was a member of the Baptist Church.

She was preceded in death by two great grandsons, Dakota and Jerry, her parents, three sisters and seven brothers.
