William Riley Seevers, III, the 3rd boy of 13 kids (7 boys & 6 girls) was born in Des Arc, Arkansas, December 19, 1942 to Lula Faye (Chapman) and William (Bill) Riley Seevers. Bill passed away at Alva Oklahoma on February 15, 2017 at the age of 74 yrs. 1 mo. and 27 days.

Bill attended school in Des Arc before moving to Carmen, Oklahoma in 1960. He worked for Parker Hardware, in Cherokee, Pettit's House of Carpet and Fuson's in Alva as a carpet layer, before going to work in the oil field. He began working in the late 80's as a maintenance worker at NWOSU, just three months short of 30 years.

Bill married Shirley Valdez in Des Arc, Arkansas on October 23, 1962. To their marriage three children: Mark, Dennis, and Derek were born.

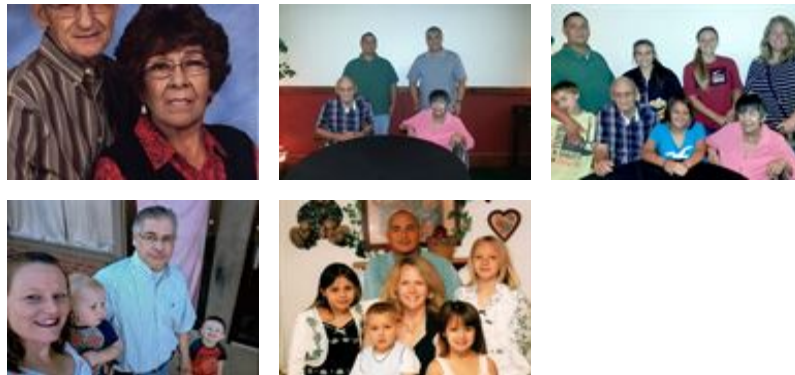
